The Contemporary Philosophy Master offers an international course focused on contemporary philosophy debates and taught at the UMR STL (Knowledge, Texts, Language research lab) and at the philosophy department.

- Compose a bibliography and master the documentary tools

The **M2 Contemporary philosophy** program in Lille is now coupled with a M1 in Philosophy taught entirely in English at the [Univ. of Lisbon \(Portugal\)](#). Students following both years will earn a Master's degree from both universities.

To enter this program, you must apply for the M1 program in Lille (with a research project written in English and a proof of your English level).

The Master contains two elements: Active involvement in 5 seminars (2 hours/week each) and 2 language courses (english or french) and Research thesis writing (minimum 75 pages), under the supervision of a professor from the

Philosophy Department. You will need to present your thesis in front of a jury.
